

FISH AND LOAVES MARKET VENDOR POLICIES

A market will be held each Saturday through the summer months, beginning July 5, 2008 and ending August 30, 2008 at Grace Chapel , 8505 S. Valley Hwy., Englewood, CO. The market will be set up on the parking lot south of the church. The market hours will be from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Reserving space:

Each seller space will be the size of 2 parking spaces. There will be numbers to define spaces and each seller is required to keep their merchandise inside their assigned space to maintain the walkways. The fee per space is as follows:

July 12 \$30

July 19 \$40

July 26 \$40

Saturdays in August \$40 each (Two weekends for \$70)

To reserve a space, please comply with the following:

1. Read and understand these Vendor Policies.
2. Print, complete and sign attached Vendor Agreement. (**Signed Vendor Agreement must accompany payment in order to participate in the market.**)
3. Make check or money order payable to Fish and Loaves Market and mail to **PO Box 630995, Littleton, Co 80163-0995** along with the signed Vendor Agreement. (**Payment must be received at least 3 days prior to market date.**)
4. You will be notified of confirmation of your reservation (by email or phone) when payment is received.

Vendors welcome to sell at Fish and Loaves Market:

Hobbyists, crafters, small business owners, homeowners, garage sale enthusiasts, entrepreneurs, sales reps., organizations, farmer's market, etc.

Prohibited Items:

The sale or give away of any prepared food or drink items is strictly prohibited. This does not include unprepared fresh fruit or vegetables. Other prohibited items and types of merchandise include:

- Guns, Ammunition, Explosives, Weapons
- Drug Paraphernalia
- Marijuana related items
- Live animals
- Any pornographic material
- Objectionable books, magazines, pictures, etc.
- Trademarked/Counterfeit merchandise
- Games of chance or skill, lotteries or auctions
- Political materials

Fish and Loaves Market reserves the right at any time to have access to a seller's space, inspect all merchandise and prohibit the sale of any merchandise it deems counter-productive to the Christian ideals on which it is founded. Sellers refusing to abide by the above will be asked to leave the property.

Inclement Weather Policy

Sorry, no refunds. Many times the weather will change in a matter of minutes resulting in a great selling day.

Sales Tax

It is the vendor's responsibility to collect sales tax For information on either a standard or special event sales tax license, you may go online to www.taxcolorado.com or call the Colorado Department of Revenue at (303) 238-7378.

Indemnification by Vendor

Vendor hereby agrees to indemnify and hold Fish and Loaves Market harmless from any losses, damages, liabilities, claims, actions, judgments, court costs and legal or other expenses (including reasonable attorney fees) which Vendor may incur as a consequence of any violation of the policy and regulations agreement of the Fish and Loaves Market.

Rules

1. Sellers must have a valid driver's license.
2. Sellers must be 18 years of age or older.
3. Sellers must complete and sign the Vendor Agreement.
4. Sellers may arrive as early as 7:00 a.m. to set up their booths.
5. Sellers may bring their vehicles onto the selling area to unload their wares, but must move vehicles off the lot no later than 8:30 a.m.
6. There will be no driving on the lot once the market has begun.
7. If a seller must leave before the market ends, he/she must use other means than a vehicle to cart merchandise off the lot.
8. Sellers must be in their reserved selling places and out of the aisles by 8:45 a.m.
9. All selling must conclude by 4:00 p.m. and sellers must be off the lot by 5:00 p.m.
10. It is the vendor's responsibility to remove all merchandise and waste belonging to them, from the lot.
11. Sellers must keep their merchandise out of the walkway areas.
12. Sellers using shade stands or covers must have them sufficiently weighted to be safe. Nails or anchors can not be driven into the

pavement. Rubber casters or pieces of wood must be placed under legs of all furniture and equipment to eliminate the possibility of pavement damage.

13. The market is a designated non-smoking area.
14. Appropriate dress is required.
15. The purchase of a space constitutes an agreement by the seller to comply with all rules and regulations. Fish and Loaves Market reserves the right to revoke any reservation and evict violators.
